



 - ③ Volume and cursor buttons (--, +-), VOL/CURSOR)
- Display, capital/lower case button (DISP, CAPS)
- Tone/recording sensitivity/space button (EQ/REC SENS, SPACE)
- Play and record mode/character delete button (MODE, DELETE)
- Play/record/pause/operation on/ character type button (►/II, CHARA)
- Stop/power off/edit cancel button
- Changing edit mode, changing track mark mode, completing edit button (EDIT, MARK MODE)


